Chardonnay 2015

This beautiful unoaked Chardonnay has a medium body and a crisp finish. You will find aromas of citrus, pear, apples and a hint of summer sun.

Sauvignon Blanc 2017

Crisp, elegant and fresh pairing well with cheese and fruit. A great summer wine, with notes of green apple, spring grasses and grapefruit.

Viognier 2016

This is a French varietal from the Rhone Valley, with strong floral notes and very fragrant on the nose. It delivers perfumed notes of fruits and flowers.

Rosé of Grenache 2016

Dry, tangy, full of flavor with a mildly sweet finish. Excellent any afternoon, paired with a light snack or a lovely full bodied meal.

Estate Pinot Noir 2014

Our Estate Pinot Noir is a full robust pinot, with a strong nose of wet soil, leather and black fruits.

White House Block Pinot 2014

The White House Pinot is grown on the block right next to the historic Mayerdale Estate. A focused wine, direct and elegant in the finish with a deeper red translucency that compliments the elegance of the finish.

Cuvee Rouge 2015

Beautiful and rich, an excellent table wine. A blend of Merlot, Syrah, and Grenache. The color is deep and rich with jammy notes and a balanced finish.

Grenache 2015

Berry flavored and soft on the palate. Deep in color with rich dark red fruit flavors and a mildly spicy, pepper finish.

Merlot 2015

Strong and well-balanced, bold in color with a glorious smooth finish. This is a great go-to food pairing wine and a wonderful choice for any occasion.

Nebbiolo 2013

Big, bold and elegant. The varietal hails from the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. The color is as light as a pinot, but full in body and crisp in the delivery. Don't let it's transparency fool you.

Syrah 2015

Rich, medium to full bodied wine with a deep color and black fruit flavors. Smooth and well balanced.

Primitivo 2016

Grapes descend from the rare Croatian varietal Primitivo and known in the states as the clone Zinfandel. Big dark fruit, dense with a soft and creamy finish, this is our newest release.

Tempranillo 2015

This Spanish varietal is from the Rioja region, and needs a dryer landscape to flourish. A savory wine that can be fresh and fruity when young but leathery and earthy after some age.
